NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR THE PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of an opportunity for public comment and public hearing on the proposed substantial amendments to the use of Washington County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for Program Year 2021.

Proposed Annual Action Plan Amendments:

- Swap funding in the amount of up to \$300,000 CDBG funding from the Home Improvement Loan Program and create the acquisition and disposition of real property project acquired with CDBG funds in accordance with 570.201(b). The Washington County CDA will purchase the property utilizing CDBG funds. The CDBG funds will then reduce the fair market value of real property by sale and donation to a developer for affordable housing.
