Eligibility Criteria:

1. United States citizen or a noncitizen with eligible immigrant status.
2. Have a social security number for each family member on the application.
3. Income qualified according to household size.

Public Housing eligibility is based on income, with residents paying 30% of their adjusted income.

- 2-person household - preference given to household income of \$29,800 or less
- 3-person household - preference given to household income of \$33,550 or less
- 4-person household - preference given to household income of \$37,250 or less

Currently we have openings for two-bedroom units with a minimum of two occupants, and maximum of four occupants.
